This year's event is on the West Coast in Northern California and hosted by Kim Cabrera and her committee. Kim's Committee has selected YMCA Camp Ravenclyff and it is located in the heart of California Redwood country in Southern Humboldt County. Partially bordering on Humboldt Redwoods State Park, with access to groves of towering ancient redwoods. The Camp occupies a beautiful meadow and a wooded hillside on the banks of the South Fork of the Eel River. It is near the small towns of Redway and Garberville, off Highway 101, about an hour south of Eureka or about a 200 mile five hour drive north from the SF/Oakland area. Group transportation is being arranged from the Bay Area Airports at an additional fee, but once you get to camp, we'll take care of the rest!

You can tent camp or be housed in the camper cabins. They each have 10 bunks and thin mattresses, cubbies for belongings, and a table. Ravenclyff is equipped with centralized regular bathrooms and showers and there is electricity in the common buildings which include restrooms, the Lodge/Dining Hall and program buildings.

All of your meals are provided: 2 Breakfasts (Sat Sun), 2 Lunches (Sat Sun), 2 Dinners (Fri Sat), and 2 Evening Snacks (Fri Sat). Please indicate on the back of your registration form if you have any special dietary needs or concerns. You will be unrestricted to attend any or all presentations. In years past we have witnessed random acts of tracking taking place, which we openly encourage. Unscheduled mentoring may pop-up and takes to the field ... occasionally spontaneous tracking activities with some renown trackers occur throughout the weekend.

We will attempt to connect people that have matching Flight times

and strongly suggest Sharing a Rental Car.

and what your travel plans will be.

We may get a lot of people that are flying into San Francisco or Oakland Airports. If we get a large quantity of people coming in by air travel we will consider renting a large Van or contracting a small Bus. A rendezvous point between these two main airports (SFO OAK) will be the Sonoma County Airport via a common carrier ‘Airport Express’. At this location we can pick up people in mass and get them to the Camp together.

If this interests you, you must fly into Oakland or San Francisco before 10:00AM on Friday to make this connection. They (Airport Express) will leave the airports at 10AM sharp!

- 1) Catch the “AIRPORT EXPRESS” commuter bus – Destination: the Sonoma County Airport drop. www.airportexpressinc.com**

(At the time of this printing - will cost you about \$28 each way – this is a private company and we have no ability to negotiate a different price for you)

- 2) We will rendezvous at the Sonoma Airport and leave at 12:30 on Friday**

- 3) A Van or mini-buss will drive you up to the camp (5 hours).**

(At the time of this printing - will cost you \$60 round trip – we are currently trying to get a better price and the more that ride the price will go down.)

- 4) This same Van and driver will leave the Camp on Sunday in time to get you back to catch the “AIRPORT EXPRESS” at the Sonoma Airport by 6:45PM that should get you to each Airport in time for a 9:45PM Flight out of OAK or a 9:30PM out of SFO**

The Camp Ravenclyff can hold everyone, however it can not take RVs bigger than a Camper on a Pickup. Off-Site arrangements for RVs and those that choose a different place to lay your head must be arranged by you. Here is an ample list for you to select from. ISPT does not guarantee a comfort level at any of the listed sites. However, I (Del) have personally camped at most of the State Parks listed and have also slept at the Benbow Inn ... these I can vouch for. If you make OFF-SITE ARRANGEMENTS you will need to understand that travel into and out of Camp must be "SLOW" and as minimal as possible. We can assist in getting you to the conference each day – let us know.
